"NO PERSON SHALL (1) DISCHARGE A FIREARM, CROSSBOW OR LONG BOW IN SUCH A WAY AS WILL RESULT IN THE LOAD, BOLT OR ARROW THEREOF PASSING OVER A PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR ANY PART THEREOF;

(2) DISCHARGE A FIREARM WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED FEET (500'), OR A LONG BOW WITHIN ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET (150'), OR A CROSSBOW WITHIN TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET (250') FROM A DWELLING HOUSE, FARM BUILDING OR FARM STRUCTURE ACTUALLY OCCUPIED OR USED, SCHOOL BUILDING, SCHOOL PLAYGROUND, PUBLIC STRUCTURE, OR OCCUPIED FACTORY OR CHURCH..."


