1		108	Regarding the rendering of the buffalo on page 108, do we need to absolutely design and produce the buffalo as the rendering shown?, or do we need to follow the design guidance of the rendering? or the rendering is just a reference so we can design the way we see fit with our own interpretation?	The rendering of the buffalo and associated guidance communicate the concept for the sculpture. Most important, the sculpture should be a representational work of art that is recognizable as a buffalo in a specular, or shiny, finish. The artist is welcome to interpret the concept; however, should keep in mind the baseline requirements.
2			is water feature desired? is the plinth and water feature rendering for reference only as well?	The buffalo will be installed on top of a plint that features a serene infinity edge waterfall. The design of the plinth and water feature concepts included in the RFP are being developed by OPRHP. The awarded Contractor will be consulted to ensure the sculpture and the plinth are compatible.
3			is this project require landscape design surrounding the Buffalo artwork?	The buffalo sculpture will be installed on top of a plinth which is part of a separate, general contract for the park construction. Landscape design is not required as part of the artist response, although the awarded Contractor's input on the plinth is desired once the contract is awarded.
4			Is there a height limit?	Please see RFP Section 1.3 Project Description. "The height of the buffalo should be approximately 13'-0" tall and 18'-6" long."
5			Is there a local artists/firms preference?	OPRHP has no preference.
6			Is the funding for the project secured or does it need fundraising?	The funding for this project is secured and does not need fundraising.
