

Allan H. Treman State Park Seasonal Slip Applications

Seasonal Slip Applications: Slips will be available to reserve at **9 am** on **February 1, 2025**.

The application process is **2** steps.

Step 1: Boaters should select and pay for the appropriately sized slip according to overall length of their vessel by going to **Reserve America**. Once the conditional slip reservation is made, boaters will receive a confirmation email from Reserve America with a Link to Step 2.

Step 2: Click the link in your confirmation email to complete the electronic Slip License Agreement via DocuSign. To be considered complete, all applications must include these documents:

- A valid copy of your registration **or** US Coast Guard documentation showing proof of length (expired registrations will not be accepted).
- Proof of vessel insurance (*provide a current Declarations page which shows coverage amounts).
 - *During the term of this license, Licensee must hold a policy of marine protection and indemnity insurance for the licensed boat covering bodily injury, damage to property other than the boat itself, and fuel/oil spills with a minimum liability limit of \$300,000.
- A valid Boating Safety Certificate
 - *All motor boat operators, regardless of age, will need a boating safety certificate in 2025.

NOTE: In order for your slip application to be considered complete, boaters will need to complete all parts of the application process *within 10 days* of making the initial reservation. If the slip agreement, insurance, registration information and Boater Safety Certificate are not complete within 10 days, *the initial reservation will be voided and refunded, and the selected slip will be placed back online for reservation by the public.*
