Permit Terms:

- This permit is valid only for the period for which it is issued, shall not be transferred, and may be revoked at any time.
- Hunters shall comply with all applicable sections of the Environmental Conservation Law; Parks Recreation and
 Historic Preservation Law and their implementing regulations and shall hunt in the manner prescribed by the
 Department of Environmental Conservation, except as modified by the dates, times and hunting styles specified in this
 permit. This permit confers only those rights indicated herein.
- Hunters must carry their permit, hunting license and photo I.D. while hunting or scouting in the Park and produce them on request to any law enforcement officer or park employee. Any unauthorized alteration will void your permit.
- This permit is valid only in zoned hunting areas.
- No person shall hunt in an area of a park that is posted or otherwise identified as a "Restricted Area."
- Cutting, placing nails or screws into, or otherwise damaging trees or other vegetation is prohibited.
- Target and promiscuous shooting is prohibited.
- No off-road vehicle traffic is allowed on trails. Vehicles must park in designated parking areas only.
- The possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- Permittee shall report any unusual incidents directly to the Park Manager or Park Police.
- All DEER Hunting at Evangola is BOW or CROSSBOW ONLY.
- Late Small Game Hunting is shotgun/bow or crossbow only. (no rifles allowed) (zone 3 closed)
- Deer Hunting will be open during archery season, regular season and late season
- Check with NYSDEC for all season dates

Zones

- 1. Zones are first come first serve
- 2. Zone 1 Zone 2 and Zone 3 have a maximum of 2 hunters while Zone 4 has a maximum of 1 hunter
- 3. Each Hunter MUST sign into and out of their specific zone on the info board every time they hunt
- 4. Sign-ins include Name, Phone Number, Vehicle Plate Number and Vehicle Description
- 5. All hunters must sign out when leaving park property **for any reason** and by doing so will forfeit their spot in that zone.
- 6. No hunter sign-ins will be allowed prior to $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours before legal sunrise
- 7. This is a first come, first served hunting opportunity. Any available zone can be hunted no reservations or signing for other hunters
- 8. All hunters will park in the designated parking areas
- 9. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE SIGN IN/OUT PROCEDURES SET FORTH ABOVE WILL AFFECT THE HUNTING PRIVILEGES OF THOSE INVOLVED. ALL ACTIVITY WILL BE CLOSELY SCRUTINIZED

Permit Terms Continued:

TREESTANDS

Portable tree stands/ladder stands are allowable at Evangola but there will be no cutting of shooting lanes by damaging trees, or placing any screws, nails, or other devices into the trees!

- Stands may be placed in the park beginning **September 1**st and must be removed by March 31st.
- A **maximum of 1 tree stand per hunter per zone** to be left on park property
- Tree stands **MUST** be **clearly labeled** with **owners Name and accurate Phone Number** (cell preferred) Non-Labeled Stands **WILL** be removed
- No Hunters may climb in or hunt from someone else's tree stand without consent from owner
- Having a tree stand does not prevent others from hunting that immediate area
- Having a tree stand in the park does not prohibit others from being in zones for purposes other than hunting
- We accept NO responsibility for any stands left on park property
- Hunters must report all deer taken per DEC regulations and must accurately record all harvested deer on sign in/out sheet
