Grafton Lakes State Park Boat Rental Rules

1. You must be 18 or older to rent a boat. The lessee must be on board the boat, are responsible for all people on the boat and must ensure all occupants understand the terms of this agreement.
2. Everyone must wear a securely fastened Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD) while in the boat.
3. All Personal Flotation Device (PFD) have an emergency whistle. Use this whistle **ONLY** if there is an emergency or face consequences from the park.
4. Absolutely NO SWIMMING is allowed from the boat. Swimming is allowed only in the designated swimming area only.
5. Absolutely NO BEACHING the boat (pulling it on shore and getting out – INCLUDING THE ROCK ISLAND! Only load/unload at the docks)
6. You must always REMAIN SEATED while in the boat and may not conduct horseplay, racing, splashing, etc.
7. You may not exceed the stated boat capacity and there are no pets or alcoholic beverages allowed in the boat.
8. In the event of thunder or lightning strike, you must immediately proceed to shore or the boat dock (Whichever is closest)
9. Any accident or incident involving the boat must be reported to concession staff immediately. If the boat capsizes, STAY WITH THE BOAT – DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SWIM TO SHORE.
10. You must return the boat, paddle(s)/oars and PFDs before closing time (6pm). Additionally, any damage to the boat, damage to and/or loss of the equipment, excessive dirt/water or discarded garbage and violation of any rule may result in the forfeiture of your boat rental deposit and possible summons and fine.
