- Hunters are required to have a Hunting Permit issued by OPRHP, in addition to their DEC issued license.
- Deer hunting is only allowed in season as specified by the hunting permit and within designated areas as shown on the map.
- Hunting for species other than deer is entirely prohibited.
- Hunting is not permitted within 500 feet of any structure, parking lot or within 150 feet of any road.
- Shooting from or across trails is entirely prohibited.
- Follow all hunter parking rules as outlined with permit.
- All boundaries and trails shown on the map are approximate.
