PARTIAL LIST OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALCOHOL: Possession or consumption of beer, wine or other liquor is prohibited.

BUSES: In NY, busses are allowed at Bear Mountain, Anthony Wayne, Welch and Rockland Lake. Permit applications must be obtained at least two weeks in advance from the Park offices. In NJ, buses are allowed at Ross Dock on weekdays and Saturdays, excluding holidays. Contact NJ Headquarters for a permit.

COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC: Trucks, buses, RV/motor homes, vehicles towing trailers, and vehicles with commercial plates or advertising may not use the Parkway or Park roads. Pick-up trucks with passenger plates may use the road.

FIRES: Fires are allowed only in grills or existing fireplaces in picnic areas or shelters. Use only downed wood. Ground fires are prohibited. Patrons should bring grills and **MUST** extinguish fires before putting ashes in designated cans.

FLOURA & FAUNA: Destruction, damage, removal or introduction of trees, shrubs, flowers and wildlife is prohibited. Visitors should not feed or touch any wildlife and should follow recommended procedures for avoiding poison ivy, ticks and poisonous snakes.



























LITTER & RECYCLING: Place refuse and recyclables in the separate containers provided. Many of our parks promote a "carry-in, carry-out" policy. Littering, polluting or dumping is prohibited.

PERMITS: Permits are required in advance for 1) outings involving 50+ people, 2) commercial photography or filming, 3) metal detecting (Lake Welch Beach only), 4) wood gathering (NY parks only), 5) educational research, 6) amplified music (Anthony Wayne only). Guests can reserve picnic areas (not tables or parking spaces) at Minnewaska, Rockland Lake, Nyack Beach, or Alpine. Some permits require payment of a fee. If in doubt about an activity, please call.

PETS: Pets, properly leashed at all times, may be taken on trails. They are prohibited in buildings, camping areas, beaches, and picnic areas. **ONLY** Lake Tiorati, Lake Kanawauke and Lake Silvermine allow properly leashed pets in the picnic area.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: The possession and/or use of alcohol, drugs, fireworks, explosives, traps, snares, axes, chainsaws, generators and other weapons or cutting tools is prohibited. Firearms or bows and arrows may be used for hunting where permitted.

PROPERTY DAMAGE: Defacing, destroying or otherwise altering Park Property is strictly prohibited. Do not put or make any kind of markings on trees, rocks, roads, or structures.
