Notification of Racing Shell Regatta

Note: As prescribed by §34-a. of the New York State Navigation Law, educational or amateur rowing organizations must file a notification setting forth dates, a description of the race course and the number of entrants in each race. All sections of the New York State Navigation Law must be followed. The filing of this Notification does not allow for the exclusive use of any waterway nor does it permit the placement of unattended floating objects. Should an applicant wish to have these added protections please fill out the **Application for a Marine Regatta Permit.**

-INSTRUCTIONS-

- **1.** Complete all applicable sections of the attached notification. Since this form may have to be reproduced, it is requested that a typewriter or black ink **only** be used in filling out this form.
- **2.** Attach an accurate section of a chart or **scale drawing** of the waterway upon which the event is to be held, indicating: 1) the boundaries of the Racing Shell Regatta area, 2) the various courses, 3) areas to be used for official boats, 4) starting and finishing lines, 5) launching pits, 6) area to be used for spectator craft, 7) a description of how various areas are marked, 8) location of any officials' stand, 9) distances from shore, and any other information you deem relevant to the event. The drawing must show that other recreational and commercial boating traffic have sufficient room to maneuver around the event. If the size of the waterway does not permit sufficient room, include details as to how traffic will be guided through the course during the event.
- ***For events on the Erie Barge Canal, the Champlain Canal, Mohawk River and all connecting waterways notifications must be made to the New York State Parks. For more information on racing shell regattas for this area please call (518) 474-0445.
- ***For events taking place in the Adirondack or Catskill Park regions notifications must be made to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. For more information on racing shell regattas for this area please call (518) 473-9518.
- **3.** This notification will be used to advise local and state marine law enforcement of this event in order that they may ensure the safety of the race participants and spectators. For this reason this package MUST be submitted to State Parks <u>at least 30 days prior to the date of the event</u>.
